At Camp CommUNITY high school students in Tarrant County of various backgrounds, identities, beliefs, and experiences, come together to heighten personal awareness, build meaningful friendships, and promote positive social change.

## Who can Apply?

Area high school students entering their junior or senior year as of September 2012.

Applicants are endorsed by high school officials or sponsoring agencies.

## How Much Does It Cost?

The cost of Camp CommUNITY is \$300. This includes round-trip transportation on a chartered bus, three meals a day, evening snacks, lodging, a 24-hour registered nurse, lifeguard, workshop materials, recreation, and more.

Partial scholarships are available to Delegates. However, Delegates are encouraged to earn as much of the camp cost as possible.

## I want to be a part of the Camp CommUNITY experience... what do I do next?

To attend Camp CommUNITY:

- Obtain an application from The Multicultural Alliance or download it from: [www.mcatexas.com](http://www.mcatexas.com)
- Seek a high school official, agency sponsor or youth advisor to sign your application endorsing your attendance.
- Return the completed application to The Multicultural Alliance by May 2, 2012. The sooner you apply, the better your chance of attending Camp CommUNITY. There are limited slots. Please include the \$25 non-refundable registration fee (which will be applied to the \$300 camp tuition).



## When do I find out?

Applicants will be notified by May 10 or sooner. Camp tuition must be paid in full before the start of camp. Once accepted to Camp CommUNITY, further information will be sent to prepare for the camp experience.
